

## **Pickleball Guidelines for Return to Play**

### **Please do not attend if:**

- You have been or feel ill with fever, cough, or shortness of breath.
- You have been exposed to or had close contact with a person who has or may have COVID 19.
- Are currently waiting on COVID-19 results.

### **What should I expect when I arrive at the WROC?**

- Entrance and exit will be through the main WROC doors located behind the church. All other entrances will be locked.
- Participants are to **arrive no earlier than 10 minutes** before start time and exit immediately after the session.
- Players will check in at the WROC entrance. Check-in areas are marked for social distance.

### **What Health and Safety procedures are in place?**

- To allow for social distancing there will be 26 players maximum per session. Players will select a seat upon arrival, and this is their seat for the evening. Water bottles and all belongings are kept at the player's designated seat.
- Hand sanitizer stations are available.
- Please bring your own water bottles. For safety, the fountains will not be in use.
- Balls are sanitized and replaced after each game.

### **How will the WROC be cleaned and sanitized?**

- Cleaning agents used to sanitize the facilities and equipment are EPA compliant to neutralize viruses including COVID-19.
- High-touch areas will be disinfected frequently throughout the day.
- The WROC will be disinfected daily and between each use of the facility.
- Disinfecting stations have been set up in the WROC.
- HVAC adjustments and filter replacements have been installed following CDC guidance.
- An air ionization system has been installed to purify the indoor air by eliminating airborne particulates, odors and pathogens.
